FISH has received a grant from the National Association of Conservation Districts. Kris Schaedel led the application for a number of Hood River County projects related to food security. We will receive \$6200.00 total. \$3200 will be spent on design and installation of irrigation in the east field of the garden. \$3000 will be spent for development of youth education, including building of projects and purchase of materials which facilitate this. Funds are to be spent by November 2025.
